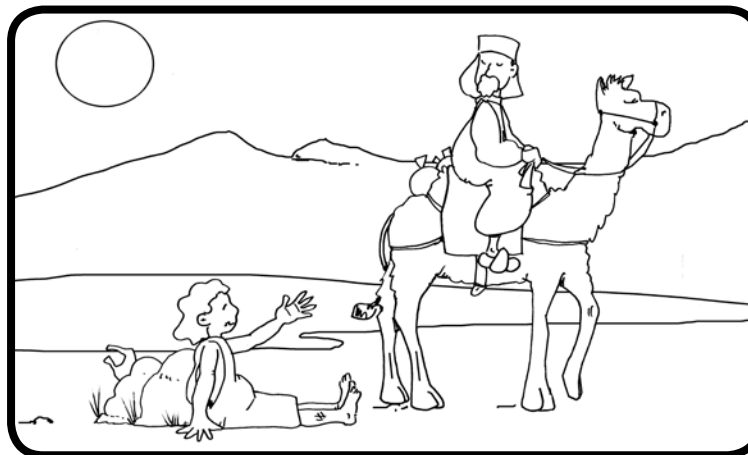


Be the first to love at home, too!

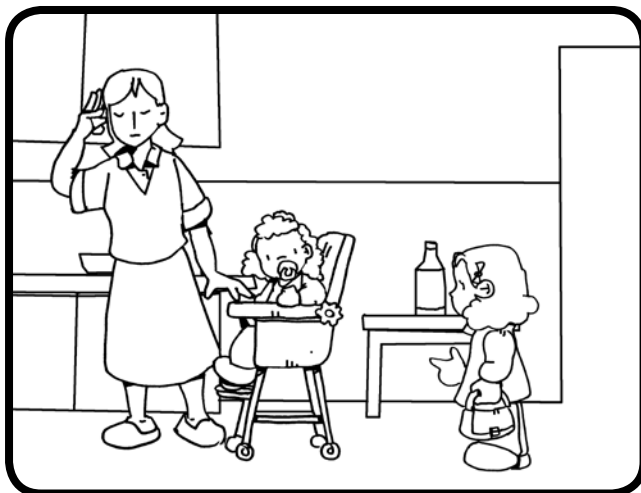
"We know that we have passed from death to life because we love one another." (1 Jn 3:14)

The first Christians thought about Jesus a lot because he had died for everyone.

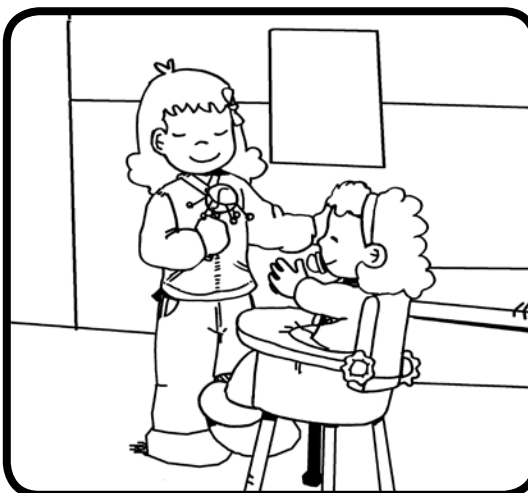

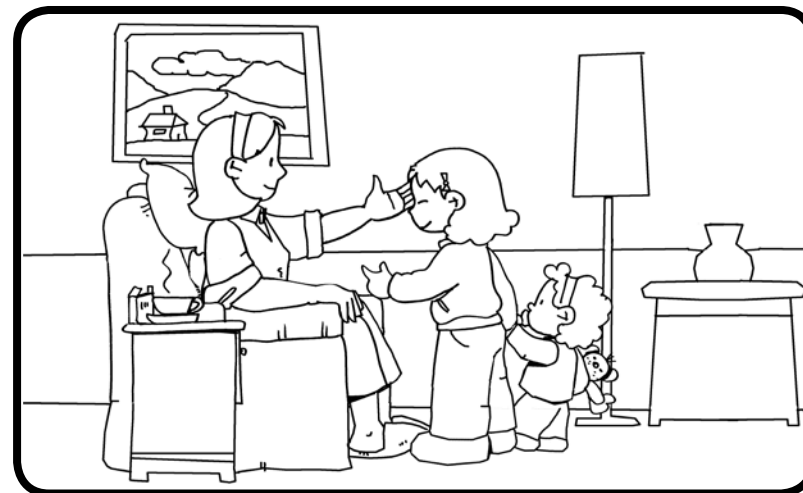
We Gen 4 want to love in concrete ways, too, starting with our own families.
